Lloydminster Bobcats Scholarship Application

As part of the legacy from hosting the 2016 RBC Cup, the Lloydminster Bobcats Hockey Club has set up a fund that could provide for up to (five) one-thousand-dollar scholarships a year, until the fund is depleted. The starting value of the fund was \$60,000.

The Scholarship is designed to provide some financial support to those players that are going to post-secondary school after their Minor or Junior hockey eligibility is over. The annual winners will be selected at the discretion of the committee.

Recognizing Academic Excellence and Community Service

The Bobcats Scholarship program is designed to provide an opportunity for players that have played for the Jr. A Bobcats and/or players that have been registered with the Lloydminster Minor Hockey Association to apply for a scholarship based on their academic accomplishments and community services involvement.

To be eligible for a Bobcats Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- All applicants must have been carded by the Lloydminster Jr. A Bobcats and/or played within the LMHA.
- All applicants must be registered or applying to a post-secondary institution.
- All applicants must complete application in full.
- All applicants must include a current academic post-secondary and high school transcript with their application.
- No applicant can win the scholarship more than once

Applications must be typed and completed in their entirety. Please attach only materials requested. Scholarship funds will be made payable to the post-secondary institution of the applicant's choice.
